Extemporaneous Speech (open to 6th, 7th and 8th grade students)

Extemporaneous Speaking students speak persuasively or informatively about current events and politics. The student/speaker chooses a question out of 3 offered then prepares for 30 minutes a 7-minute speech on the topic.

Wednesday 4:30-6:30 pm

Public Forum Debate (open to 7th and 8th grade students)

In Public Forum Debate you debate with a partner on a topic of national importance on foreign and domestic policies. Debaters learn to make persuasive and logical arguments in a manner that is accessible to a wide variety of audiences. You learn to research and develop arguments to support your position on a topic. The National Forensic League votes on the monthly topics we debate.

Thursday 4:30-6:30 pm

Each class is **\$395** per season plus a **\$25** registration fee per student. The registration fee will cover the enrollment fee for 1 year and materials for the class. Tournament entry fees will be the parent's responsibility (fees range from \$5-\$15 per event). Plan to attend a minimum of 3-5 tournaments per season. **Registration is now open for incoming 6th, 7th and 8th grade students of Carroll ISD.**
