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- **Session 1 – Mad Scientist – June 6-9, 9:00-noon**

Step into the lab and start stirring things up. Explore chemical reactions that bubble, pop and ooze. Concoct your own slime and glow in the dark goo. Make your own snow and explode a Mentos fountain. Blow bubbles as big as your head for everyone to see!

- **Session 2 – Dragons of the Round Table – June 6-9, 1:00-4:00pm**

Have you always wanted to be a Knight of the Round Table? If so, come join the fun. Construct a fortress that can withstand an attack from your enemy. Create your own coat of arms and design your own lance to use in a joust. Build your very own catapult that will help you in laying siege to the enemy.

- **Session 3 – Dragon Doctors – June 13-16, 9:00-noon**

Explore what makes the human body both gross and amazing. Dissect a sheep's brain and a cow's eyeball to discover how these organs work. Make edible blood and edible poop that will gross out your family. Learn how the kidney removes urine and the tongue helps you taste. Leave camp as the resident expert on wacky body science facts!

- **Session 4 – Zombie camp – June 13-16, 1:00-4:00pm**

Do you know how to recognize a Zombie? If not, this is the camp for you. Learn how to identify a Zombie both on the inside and outside of their bodies. Dissect Zombie's brain, test other campers for the Zombie virus, and collect samples of Zombie snot. Come and create your own Zombie Survival Kit in order to be prepared for a Zombie invasion.

- **Session 5 – Mad Scientist – June 20-23, 9:00-noon**

Step into the lab and start stirring things up. Explore chemical reactions that bubble, pop and ooze. Concoct your own slime and glow in the dark goo. Make your own snow and explode a Mentos fountain. Blow bubbles as big as your head for everyone to see!

- **Session 6 – Build 'Em and Break 'Em – June 20-23, 1:00-4:00pm**
