An ideal solution for parents seeking extended schoolyear learning through summer fun, the Camp Invention program is a safe, creative outlet for children in grades one through six to explore the unknown, tinker with ideas, and satisfy their natural sense of curiosity teaching them how to think like leaders and entrepreneurs.

Camp Invention will be led by qualified local educators. This unique program challenges children to think creatively about real-world problems and work as a team to collectively identify solutions.

This year's ENVISION program features:

Gadget Garage: Widgets, Gizmos, and Contraptions™: Children become studio crew members for a television show on the Explore Technology channel. These young studio crew members will use design thinking and creative problem solving to help design, create and test gadgets that solve viewer challenges live on air.

Magnetropolis<sup>TM</sup>: Participants are recruited to find a magnificent island by navigating hand-crafted, upcycled ships to the last known location of the island while exploring science skills such as buoyancy, orienteering and magnetism. Children rebuild the island to scale using engineering design and mathematics.

Inventureureka™: Participants will take a fantasy adventure on the Ci6000 Space Modulator Time Machine to explore serendipitous moments in invention history. Participants will build their own inventions and learn more about both the innovative as well as the adaptive parts of the invention process.

I Can Invent: Balloon Burst ™: Working in teams, younger children focus on building inventions that burst water balloons, while older children create multi-step, balloon-bursting Rube Goldberg-type machines, signifying their success.
